




<b>Summary of the Event</b>	<p>The workshop began with the registration process. Participants were given the resources and softwares to be installed in pendrives. The workshop introduction was done on gaming and its effect on society. Participants were made aware of the various pros and cons of gaming and gaming addiction was discussed. Then the Unity engine was introduced to the participants. Few topics like machine learning , artificial intelligence and neural networks were then explained. They were given hands on and practical examples and tasks to do in parallel to the instructors. They tried out different simple examples on how machine learning was used to train AI in games.
