Summary of the Event	Telangana Ku Haritha Hāram National Forest Policy of India envisages a minimum of 33% of the total geographical area under forest / tree cover to maintain environmental stability and ecological balance; that are vital for sustenance of all lifeforms, human, animal and plants. Telangana Ku Haritha Haaram, a flagship programme of the Telangana Government envisages to increase the present 24% tree cover in the State to 33% of the total geographical area of the State. The thrust areas to achieve the above are two-fold; one, initiatives in notified forest areas, and the other, initiatives in areas outside the notified forest areas. The first objective is sought to be achieved by a multi-pronged approach of rejuvenating degraded forests, ensuring more effective protection of							

	forests against smuggling, encroachment, fire, grazing and intensive soil and moisture conservation measures following the watershed approach. Major fillip is sought to be given to Social Forestry for achieving the second objective. In the areas outside the notified forest, massive planting activities will be taken up in areas such as; road-side avenues, river and canal bank, barren hill, tank bunds and foreshore areas, institutional premises, religious places, housing colonies, community lands, municipalities, industrial parks, etc. Legend District Boundary Vegetation Class Dense Forest Open Forest Scrub Non Forest Water Body 230 Crore seedlings are proposed to be planted in the State during the next three years. Out of this, 130 crores seedlings are proposed to be planted outside the notified forest areas (10 crore within HMDA limits, and the remaining 120 Crores in rest of the State). It is also proposed to plant, and rejuvenate the viable rootstock to achieve 100 crore plants inside the forest areas by way of intensive protection of the forests. During 2015-16, planting drive in the entire State will be taken up in 2nd week of July. People from all walks of life, Government agencies, officers, prominent citizens, and public representatives will participate in the programme. The field functionaries of various line Departments have undertaken identification of sites for planting and prepared village Action Plans. The Village Action Plans will be consolidated at Mandal level and finally at the District level to form District Action Plan. At State level, two committees; the State Level Coordination and Monitoring Committee, and the State Level Steering Committee oversee the progress of the TKHH programme.

Summary of the Event	The Computational Intelligence Society (CIS) Student Chapter organized a seminar entitled "Career Compass: Navigating the World of Designing". We have the honor of having Mr. Sai Krishna Alishala, the founder and Chief Executive Officer of ElitCeler Technologies, as our speaker. He is well-versed in Flutter Development, UI/UX Design and has been a part of more than 10 start-ups.  The Speaker opened with an engaging session with the students, inquiring as to their knowledge of about design-related professions. He also asked what had inspired them to pursue a career in designing. The students actively participated in the discussion with the speaker and expressed their knowledge and enthusiasm for design. They shared what they knew about it, as well as what inspired them to pursue it.  He went on to discuss a few of the most cutting-edge real-time technologies such as AWS, Dart, GitHub, Node, Firebase, Kotlin and Flutter. He discussed how they were used with real-time examples and explained some design tools, such as Figma, Adobe XD, Sketch and Photoshop. He also discussed how these technologies were used in early 20th century design.  He laid out a path to make designing a career and the opportunities it offers. He discussed topics such as User Interface and User Experience designs, as well as providing an introduction to Flutter since he is a Flutter developer. With great patience and understanding, he responded to all students' queries satisfactorily.  The session ended with a vote of thanks in the presence of Principal Dr J Praveen Through this seminar, students gained an understanding of designing and how to pursue a career in it.

Overall, all the students in the room got a clear idea about the FIGMA tool which is the purpose of conducting this workshop.







Summary of the Event	Telangana Ku Haritha Hāram National Forest Policy of India envisages a minimum of 33% of the total geographical area under forest / tree cover to maintain environmental stability and ecological balance; that are vital for sustenance of all lifeforms, human, animal and plants. Telangana Ku Haritha Haaram, a flagship programme of the Telangana Government envisages to increase the present 24% tree cover in the State to 33% of the total geographical area of the State. The thrust areas to achieve the above are two-fold; one, initiatives in notified forest areas, and the other, initiatives in areas outside the notified forest areas. The first objective is sought to be achieved by a multi-pronged approach of rejuvenating degraded forests, ensuring more effective protection of							

	forests against smuggling, encroachment, fire, grazing and intensive soil and moisture conservation measures following the watershed approach. Major fillip is sought to be given to Social Forestry for achieving the second objective. In the areas outside the notified forest, massive planting activities will be taken up in areas such as; road-side avenues, river and canal bank, barren hill, tank bunds and foreshore areas, institutional premises, religious places, housing colonies, community lands, municipalities, industrial parks, etc. Legend District Boundary Vegetation Class Dense Forest Open Forest Scrub Non Forest Water Body 230 Crore seedlings are proposed to be planted in the State during the next three years. Out of this, 130 crores seedlings are proposed to be planted outside the notified forest areas (10 crore within HMDA limits, and the remaining 120 Crores in rest of the State). It is also proposed to plant, and rejuvenate the viable rootstock to achieve 100 crore plants inside the forest areas by way of intensive protection of the forests. During 2015-16, planting drive in the entire State will be taken up in 2nd week of July. People from all walks of life, Government agencies, officers, prominent citizens, and public representatives will participate in the programme. The field functionaries of various line Departments have undertaken identification of sites for planting and prepared village Action Plans. The Village Action Plans will be consolidated at Mandal level and finally at the District level to form District Action Plan. At State level, two committees; the State Level Coordination and Monitoring Committee, and the State Level Steering Committee oversee the progress of the TKHH programme.
