Summary of the Event	<p>Telangana Ku Haritha Hāram National Forest Policy of India envisages a minimum of 33% of the total geographical area under forest / tree cover to maintain environmental stability and ecological balance; that are vital for sustenance of all life-forms, human, animal and plants. Telangana Ku Haritha Haaram, a flagship programme of the Telangana Government envisages to increase the present 24% tree cover in the State to 33% of the total geographical area of the State. The thrust areas to achieve the above are two-fold; one, initiatives in notified forest areas, and the other, initiatives in areas outside the notified forest areas. The first objective is sought to be achieved by a multi-pronged approach of rejuvenating degraded forests, ensuring more effective protection of</p>				

	<p>forests against smuggling, encroachment, fire, grazing and intensive soil and moisture conservation measures following the watershed approach. Major fillip is sought to be given to Social Forestry for achieving the second objective. In the areas outside the notified forest, massive planting activities will be taken up in areas such as; road-side avenues, river and canal bank, barren hill, tank bunds and foreshore areas, institutional premises, religious places, housing colonies, community lands, municipalities, industrial parks, etc. Legend District Boundary Vegetation Class Dense Forest Open Forest Scrub Non Forest Water Body 230 Crore seedlings are proposed to be planted in the State during the next three years. Out of this, 130 crores seedlings are proposed to be planted outside the notified forest areas (10 crore within HMDA limits, and the remaining 120 Crores in rest of the State). It is also proposed to plant, and rejuvenate the viable rootstock to achieve 100 crore plants inside the forest areas by way of intensive protection of the forests. During 2015-16, planting drive in the entire State will be taken up in 2nd week of July. People from all walks of life, Government agencies, officers, prominent citizens, and public representatives will participate in the programme. The field functionaries of various line Departments have undertaken identification of sites for planting and prepared village Action Plans. The Village Action Plans will be consolidated at Mandal level and finally at the District level to form District Action Plan. At State level, two committees; the State Level Coordination and Monitoring Committee, and the State Level Steering Committee oversee the progress of the TKHH programme.</p>

<p>Summary of the Event</p>	<p>The Computational Intelligence Society (CIS) Student Chapter organized a coding contest with a bidding theme called "Code Estate". In this contest, students were presented with coding questions and given a virtual amount of 1 lakh. Now, students are supposed to bid for questions that they can solve according to their capabilities. After the bidding session, they are supposed to solve the questions that they have purchased.</p> <p>The program was initiated by Dr. P. Gopala Krishna sir (Dean, Assessments & Accreditations) ceremonially igniting the lamp. Before the contest began, students were given a paper of instructions containing the rules and regulations to be followed throughout the event. The event began with the bidding of around 45 questions, each with a different base prize. The bidding had to start from the base prize, with increments of 500 up to 10,000, and increments of 1,000 thereafter.</p> <p>The students participated in the bidding in an interactive and entertaining way, purchasing the questions. The bidding of 45 questions ended around 12:00 p.m., and after that, the students started solving the questions. The students who were facing any kind of problem while solving were given an opportunity to approach the panel for help and receive hints for a certain amount of money. Not only bidding and solving, students were also given the opportunity of trading solutions for money to improve their trading and negotiation skills. After the solving session, students were given around 15 minutes to trade their solutions. This meant that they could sell their answers to their co-participants, while those who were unable to solve their questions could buy solutions from their peers.</p> <p>After the allotted time was up, the panel decided the winners and runner-up based on the questions they solved and the money they were remained with. Winners are awarded a check of Rs.1000/- and runners receive a check of Rs.500/-, along with achievement certificates. The remaining 13 teams were given participation certificates.</p> <p>Finally, The event ended with a thank-you speech from the Chair of CIS, Mr. Shakhapuram Prashanth.</p>

Summary of the Event	<p>Telangana Ku Haritha Hāram National Forest Policy of India envisages a minimum of 33% of the total geographical area under forest / tree cover to maintain environmental stability and ecological balance; that are vital for sustenance of all life-forms, human, animal and plants. Telangana Ku Haritha Haaram, a flagship programme of the Telangana Government envisages to increase the present 24% tree cover in the State to 33% of the total geographical area of the State. The thrust areas to achieve the above are two-fold; one, initiatives in notified forest areas, and the other, initiatives in areas outside the notified forest areas. The first objective is sought to be achieved by a multi-pronged approach of rejuvenating degraded forests, ensuring more effective protection of</p>				

	<p>forests against smuggling, encroachment, fire, grazing and intensive soil and moisture conservation measures following the watershed approach. Major fillip is sought to be given to Social Forestry for achieving the second objective. In the areas outside the notified forest, massive planting activities will be taken up in areas such as; road-side avenues, river and canal bank, barren hill, tank bunds and foreshore areas, institutional premises, religious places, housing colonies, community lands, municipalities, industrial parks, etc. Legend District Boundary Vegetation Class Dense Forest Open Forest Scrub Non Forest Water Body 230 Crore seedlings are proposed to be planted in the State during the next three years. Out of this, 130 crores seedlings are proposed to be planted outside the notified forest areas (10 crore within HMDA limits, and the remaining 120 Crores in rest of the State). It is also proposed to plant, and rejuvenate the viable rootstock to achieve 100 crore plants inside the forest areas by way of intensive protection of the forests. During 2015-16, planting drive in the entire State will be taken up in 2nd week of July. People from all walks of life, Government agencies, officers, prominent citizens, and public representatives will participate in the programme. The field functionaries of various line Departments have undertaken identification of sites for planting and prepared village Action Plans. The Village Action Plans will be consolidated at Mandal level and finally at the District level to form District Action Plan. At State level, two committees; the State Level Coordination and Monitoring Committee, and the State Level Steering Committee oversee the progress of the TKHH programme.</p>



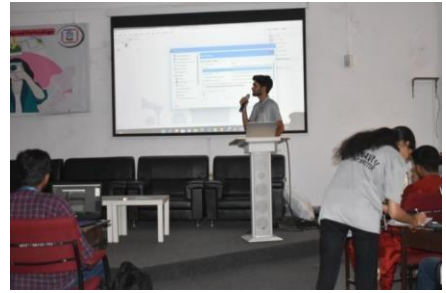

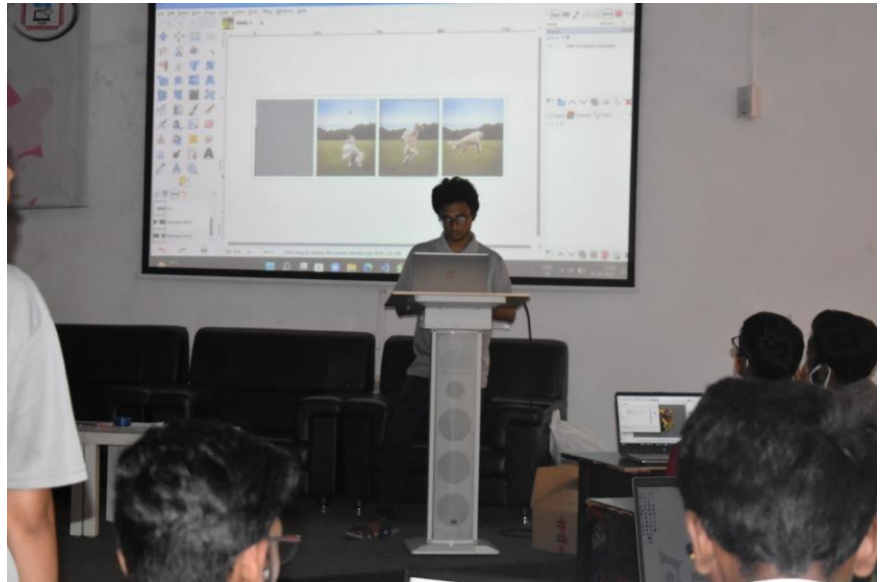
