

## Debate

A debate is a contest or an event where two or more people speak for or against an issue and try to persuade in mutual using logical argumentation. It contributes to the intellectual and ethical development of the participants. Regular participation in debate improves analytical and speaking skills that empower individuals to speak in support of themselves and discover their own views.

### **Features:**

### **Steps for a successful debate:**

Participants should realize that debate shall not develop enmity amongst them.

- Select the topic and do gather necessary information from various sources.
- Arrange it in suitable order.
- Connect the available information logically in a sequential order.
- Define the topic clearly.
- Identify the cause and effect logic.
- Think of all viable solutions and select the most suitable one.

### **Rules to follow:**

- Participants should adhere to the rules and guidelines of the format.
- Language used by participants shall be formal.
- Time management is beneficial.
- Clear and audible voice ensures success of the participant.
- Non-verbal communication like body language is also important.
- Simple and clear language avoids confusion and complication of ideas.

Be polite in expressing your self	Use of unparliamentary language
Be clear and logical	Throw arbitrary statements
Be quick to the point	Use non-words and beat around the bush
Be natural but control your emotions	Look annoyed or express extreme emotions

Maintain good eye contact with all the members of the opposite group	Avoid eye contact or stare fixedly
Sit comfortably with a polite posture and express ideas using proper gestures	Sit carelessly, legs crossed or shaking you legs or thumbing the table
Take care regarding correct pronunciation, optimum speed and proper sentence construction	Put on an accent, be too fast or slow
